About the Austin Young Chamber

AYC was created in July 2009 to connect young professionals across different industries. What began as an eager group of volunteers seeking to create opportunities for peer-to-peer connection has turned into the largest and fastest-growing young professional organization in Austin with a full time staff and an annual operating budget of \$400k. The Austin Young Chamber of Commerce is a 501c6 membership association based in Austin, Texas.

Our Members

AYC has over 600 annual dues-paying members and approximately 2,500 who take part in our programs each year. The membership has a near-even split of males and females; average age is early to mid-30s; with average household incomes over \$80,000. Our members work in just about every industry: tech, finance, education, insurance, law, non-profit, real estate, marketing/PR, sales, HR, and more. No industry represents more than ~10% of total membership. More detailed demographic data is available by request.

How AYC Works

AYC's programmatic focus is on creating opportunities for members to connect with one another, the business community, and the City of Austin. While all of our programs and events are open to the community at large, members receive free or discounted pricing as well as other unique opportunities including access to partner programs and the opportunity to serve on one of seven committees. AYC programming includes three signature annual events (State of AYC Annual Luncheon; AYC Casino Social; and FAVE Awards Gala), several core monthly/quarterly programs (Coffee Connection, Let's Talk – Speed Networking, Speaker Series, plus some unique workshops, lunch & learns, and happy hours) and a variety of programs each month planned and executed by committee members (including opportunities to hear from local elected officials about upcoming developments or public policy; a special young professionals evening at one of many performing arts shows; a day of volunteering at a local hospital or shelter, etc).
